lowa's Labor Force Participation

- Labor force levels are recovering
 - Up to 1.74 million, only 9,000 below pre-pandemic high
- Manufacturing employment in Iowa is strong
 - April number hit highest level since May 2008
- Nationally, women's employment has hit a record high
 - Women's employment in Iowa has recovered faster than national
- lowa has seen growth while neighboring states have lost (IL and MN)
 - July 2023 (latest data): lowa had 78,000 job openings and 47,700 unemployed people







Market Research Findings




More than 1 in 3 respondents are dissatisfied with their current cost of living. Iowa is #1 in cost of living.

Nearly 1 in 3 respondents have concerns about safety where they live. Safety is rated as one of the top-performing attributes for lowa.









Housing Assistance

Workforce Housing Tax Credits (WHTC)

 Tax benefits to developers to provide housing in lowa's communities

Federal Low-Income Housing Tax Credits (LIHTC)

 Tax incentives to investors for the development, acquisition and rehabilitation of income-restricted rental properties

Historic Preservation Tax Credits

 Encourages the sensitive rehabilitation and reuse of historic structures (e.g., schools, factories, hotels)

Redevelopment Tax Credits

Tax credits to redevelop underused industrial and commercial property





Economic Risks

- Middle East conflict impact on oil, concern for global economic downturn
 - Crude oil prices up 7% since October 4; crude futures for December up 8%
- War in Ukraine continues to impact grain exports and food prices could continue to rise
- Mississippi river near record low some estimates indicate flow of goods reduced by 45%
 - For every foot of draft lost on a barge, 6,000 bushels of soybeans can't be loaded
- Through August, soybean exports are down 8% and corn exports are down 35% (Source: WISERTrade)

Historic Tax Reform

- Tax Foundation ranking improvement of 31 places with full phase implementation of reforms
- Lowers corporate tax from 9.8% to 7.1% in 2024, with ultimate target of 5.5% by 2026
- Single income tax bracket for all lowans will reach 3.9% by 2026 (CY 2022 top tax rate was 8.53%, in CY 2023 it is 6%)
- Eliminated retirement income tax starting in 2023
